Short Courses:

Al Rawḍah Series

Al Rawḍah series is the short course wing of the madrasah.

Through the Al Rawḍah series, we offer short online courses spanning 2-6 weeks with lessons held on a weekly basis, on an array of topics. In the year 2025 some of the courses we offered are as follows:

Ambiyā' عليه السلام Defended Through the Qur'ān

This was a 5-week course that educated scholars and layman alike on the responses to commonly raised objections against the Ambiyā' عليه السلام. It further sought to impress the belief of the infallibility of the Ambiyā' عليه السلام.

A 4-week course of discovery and immersion into the blessed daughters of Rasūlullāh صلى الله عليه وسلم.

This was a 3-week, academically invigorating course dedicated to understanding the legislation and wisdoms of Sharī' Ḥudūd.

Ma'had Urwah

Ma'had Urwah is an Early Childhood Development (ECD) and Foundation Phase centre dedicated to nurturing young learners through a holistic education deeply rooted in Islāmic values. Our approach blends Qur'ānic learning, Prophetic teachings, and moral development, preparing children to grow as confident, responsible members of the Ummah.

Our curriculum is Muslim-centric, integrating the South African CAPS framework with creativity, play-based learning, and a strong Islamic ethos. Each subject, from literacy to numeracy, is infused with the remembrance of Allāh, stories of the Prophets, and the adab (etiquette) of Islām. Daily routines include Qur'ān recitation, du'ās, and Sunnah practices, shaping both mind and character.

With a warm, structured, and nurturing environment, Ma'had Urwah partners with parents to ensure education and faith go hand in hand, building a foundation where learning becomes an act of worship and every child learns to serve Allāh, the Ummah, and themselves.



Mubz Relief

Mubz Relief 2025: A Year of Growth

Guided by the Prophetic tradition, “The best of mankind are those most beneficial to mankind,” 2025 was the year where Mubz Relief endeavoured to expand its footprint locally as well as globally so as to reach more people in need. Every project is undertaken with the hope that it becomes a means of Ṣadaqah Jāriyah, benefitting communities long into the future.

Over the course of 2025, over 5000 grocery hampers were distributed to the poor. Meals for more than 500 people were prepared daily. 2025 saw the launch of our global Qurbānī effort where over 500 shares were facilitated for across South Africa, India, and Malawi.

In terms of assistance, 400 bursaries were awarded, while rental assistance, ‘Ulamā’ support, distribution of school uniforms, stationery, and winter clothing brought relief to families in need. Mubz Relief has also facilitated medical relief for those who were unable to afford escalating medical costs.



Mubz Relief also enhanced community infrastructure by providing Masjid shelving, desks, solar and inverter systems. The flagship borehole and water well projects oversaw the setup of over 120 boreholes and water wells in South Africa, Bangladesh, Malawi, Kenya, and Mozambique.

In 2025, the Mubz Relief teams undertook international missions to Syria, Malawi, Burundi, Rwanda, and Zanzibar where vital aid was provided. Furthermore, these missions were the catalyst for the establishment of many Basics of Islām and Revert Support Classes as well as the Tutorgram Program. With an eye ever fixed on Gaza, Mubz Relief carried out water distributions, feedings, and baby care projects trying our best in a desperate situation.

The Mubz Relief Team has also attended numerous meetings, engagements, and conferences in order to ensure a collaborative effort with all stakeholders and to keep abreast of the latest developments in the humanitarian sector.

As the year concludes, the Mubz Relief Team invites you to join us in our journey of growth, our journey of endeavour to serve the less fortunate and underprivileged. Through this path of khidmah, we beseech Allāh to accept these efforts and make it a means of perpetual reward for us in this World and the Hereafter.

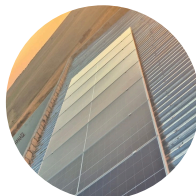
Ijrā'āt 'Uthmān ibn 'Affān رضي الله عنه

Alḥamdulillāh, to date, over 300 water facilities have been facilitated locally and internationally. The areas of focus include but are not limited to, the Western Cape, Mpumalanga, North West, Mozambique, and Bangladesh.



Ijrā'āt Zaynab bint Jahsh رضي الله عنها

Alḥamdulillāh thus far for 2025 over 5000 homes have received hampers.

Alḥamdulillāh, through this initiative solar inverter systems have been installed and gas-stoves distributed to the 'ulamā, elderly, widowed, and the Masājid to facilitate ease during load shedding.

Did You Know?

01. Ramaḍān at MUBZ



The Madrasah hosted 6 Tarāwīḥ venues in Ramaḍān with a daily pre-Tarāwīḥ discussion on the Masā'il of Safr and post-Tarāwīḥ reflections on Descriptions of Rasūlullāh صلى الله عليه وسلم in the Qur'ān.

A Digital Detox overnight programme was also facilitated at the Madrasah. This was a father/guardian and son overnight programme filled with inspirational talks, dhikr, and recitations of the Qur'ān.

Ladies programmes for spiritual upliftment were held through the month of Ramaḍān at the Madrasah.

02. Jumu'ah lectures & Anjumans

Our Asātidhah and students feature on the local Jumu'ah roster and deliver talks in the local Masājid. This serves as a perfect opportunity for our students to perfect and gain confidence in their oratory skills. Through our Imāmah wa Khiṭābah program we provide continuous support to our students for their role in the public arena.

The Madrasah had its inaugural Jumu'ah on the 15th of Sha'bān 1446 corresponding to the 14th of February 2025. The students feature weekly on the Jumu'ah roster under the guidance of the Asātidhah.

03. Da'wah and Tarbiyah



Field Base:

The Madrasah undertakes 'Field-based' trips; 'Ulamā and Dār al-'Ulūms are visited and lessons imparted.

Tablīgh:

The effort of tablīgh forms part of our Madrasah ethos. Daily ta'lim, weekly ghusht, and fikr takes place regularly. The Madrasah also goes out on 3 day and 24-hour Jamā'āt trips periodically.

Iṣlāḥ:

The madrasah has weekly iṣlāḥī and dhikr programs for the students to uplift their spirituality and hone the character of the students.

Maktab Training:

The male students were sent on a 2-day intensive to Madrasah al-Muhajirin wa al-Ansar, for a Maktab Preparedness Program by immersing themselves into the Maktab system and learning through various programs as well as practical teaching opportunities. The female students were afforded the same opportunity at our own Maktab.

Ghusl, Kafan, and Burial Practicals:

The Madrasah arranged for the students to go through the theory as well as the practical steps that ought to be taken after death. This included the post death period and its legalities, as well the ghusl, kafan, and burial procedure.

04. Skills Development and Empowerment

Our skills centre hosts courses over periods of time to provide participants with a wide array of skills in various niche trades. The centre has a fitted sewing room and large multi-station kitchen. We also offer first aid training, business management, computer literacy, and self-help workshops.

05. Dār al-Iftā'



The Madrasah has a fully-fledged Iftā' department that answers queries on a daily basis. In the year 2025 the Dārul Iftā' has responded to 600 queries that have come via our dedicated Iftā' website, email address, through WhatsApp, and via the phone line.

The Iftā' department has facilitated commercial mediation and arbitrations as well as a number of inheritance related arbitrations in the year 2025.

06. Counselling

Throughout 2025, the Counselling Department engaged with 22 individual and couple cases, offering both onsite and online support. The department addressed a broad spectrum of concerns, including anxiety, depression, and interpersonal challenges, while also conducting pre-marital, marital, and life-coaching sessions.

Basics of Islām and Reverts Support Programme

- For those who have reverted we offer lessons onsite and online, and go beyond to ensure their assimilation into the Muslim community. Our one-on-one approach through the online setting allows for those unable to study through traditional platforms a space to grow in their faith and education.

Under the banner of the Basics of Islām department, an outreach programme was held in in the Witbank location for the local Muslims of the area. It was well attended and the programmes in the vernacular language was appreciated and well received.

12 individuals reverted to Islām under the auspicious of our Basics of Islām & Revert Support Department.

The MUBZ Da'wah Mobile Pod and In-Home Da'wah Pod – Taking Service and the Message of Islām Across South Africa

- Alḥamdulillāh, this year marked a remarkable milestone in our journey of outreach and service. The MUBZ Da'wah Mobile Pod has become a reality — fully equipped with two functional medical rooms, allowing us to deliver essential healthcare and Da'wah services to communities across South Africa.

- Through the grace of Allāh Ta'ālā, and the support of dedicated professionals, 'Ulamā', and volunteers, we intend to reached areas long untouched by structured da'wah or medical care. Our teams will offer voluntary medical assistance, distribute Qur'āns and Islamic literature, and conduct educational da'wah presentations that invite to Islām with compassion and clarity.
- The Da'wah Mobile Pod will also serve as a mobile classroom, nurturing youth and new Muslims through mentorship and training in da'wah and community service.



By collaborating with relief organisations and professionals, we will extend both our reach and our impact, reviving the spirit of sacrifice and travel for Dīn that inspired our predecessors.

Together with the Da'wah Mobile, our Basics of Islām and Reverts Support Programme has also set up an In-Home Da'wah Pod to cater for the local community, answering questions about Islām, imparting education, holding workshops, and curating a dedicated Da'wah Team to impart the teachings of Islām.

Acquisitions

- ▶ Alḥamdulillāh, the Madrasah has acquired an additional property adjacent to the current Madrasah properties. This will allow us, through the grace of Allāh Ta'ālā, to expand our footprint and efforts. The Madrasah also purchased an additional shuttle to add to the current fleet.

Da'wah Boards:

- ▶ During the course of the year, the Basics of Islām and Reverts Support Programme facilitated placing various Da'wah Bill Boards in a number of towns and cities including, Middelburg, Witbank, Bela-Bela, and Modimolle, inviting all to the pristine faith of Islām. The same have also been placed on a number of passenger busses, serving as mobile Da'wah vehicles.

The Madrasah Urwah HOD System

- ▶ Our HOD system at the Dār al-'Ulūm strives for academic excellence through structured oversight and continuous development. It establishes a clear framework for each subject, outlining objectives, key resources, and teaching approaches, while ensuring consistent academic progression. Dedicated HOD meetings provide a platform for idea-sharing and collaboration, enabling teachers within and across disciplines to work in harmony toward a unified educational vision.
